Woodland Highlights

Faculty and staff cheerfully greet the students outside as they begin to arrive at 8:40 a.m. **Mr. Donahue** (music) and **Mrs. Beebe** (art) stand in the foyer reminding students of their three choices: playground, breakfast, or classroom.

In every classroom, the school day begins with **Morning Meeting**. During Morning Meeting students greet each other and engage in playful opportunities to practice the **social-emotional** skills they will need to use throughout the school day ahead.

Readers' Workshop is usually the first academic lesson of the day. Like all of the schools in our District, **student engagement** is our priority. We strive to ensure students are **reading**, **talking**, and **reflecting** during workshop lessons.

One time per month all of the students and staff gather in the gymnasium. Like Morning Meeting, we sit in a large circle/oval around the perimeter of the floor. Grade levels take turns facilitating these **Whole School Meetings (WSM)**.

Our WSMs put students at the center. Students share their work and teach our entire community songs and games for learning. Every meeting includes a guest speaker from the larger community selected by the grade level team facilitating. This month, Kindergarten is inviting a Granville resident to talk about earth day and planting.

The Woodland School Council is interested in increasing opportunities for students to engage in STEM education. This year Woodland faculty formed a building-based Technology Committee. We added depth to students' weekly technology block and we increased second grade students' technology instruction to two 45-minute sessions per week. Granville students will continue to enjoy technology class with Mrs. Welch, who also manages Woodland's library.
